The primary goal of the Community Garden Program is to provide a safe, enjoyable gardening experience.

The following guidelines are to help the garden run smoothly.

- 1. This is an **herbicide and pesticide free** garden. If you need any ideas or help with an issue in the garden, we have a local library with reference books available.
- 2. Garden plots are approximately 12 feet by 3 feet. One plot per family may be reserved.
- 3. A nominal fee of **\$20 per year is requested**.
- 4. All pets in the garden must be on a leash and picked up after.
- 5. Children are encouraged to help in the garden, but must remember not to disturb other plots.
- 6. "Work Bees" will be held as needed but expect two: one in the spring and one in the fall. Gardeners are expected to attend "Work Bees."
- 7. **Gardens must be weeded regularly**. If for some reason you are not able to weed your garden, please arrange to have someone take care of it for you. Gardeners who cannot maintain their garden plot may risk having their plot revoked. (If your weeds go to seed, you are not adequately maintaining your plot.)
- 8. Please dispose of weeds (without seeds) and plant materials in the compost areas provided.
- 9. Diseased plants must NOT be composted: they should be bagged and disposed of in your trash.
- 10. We ask that you visit you garden at least once a week, preferably more to monitor garden growth.
- 11. Garden beds marked community are for everyone's enjoyment. The fruit trees are also for community use. Thank you for your help taking care of the community garden.
